#### **Casualties**

- \* Private Matthew Clarke, 6<sup>th</sup> Bn., Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders.
- \* Captain John Ogilvie Fairlie, 10<sup>th</sup> Bn., Highland Light Infantry, of Myres Castle, Auchtermuchty.
- \* Private Peter Gray, 9<sup>th</sup> Bn., Black Watch.
- \* Private David Hardie, 5<sup>th</sup> Bn., Cameronians (Scottish Rifles).
- \* Guardsman David Pringle, 1<sup>st</sup> Bn., Scots Guards. Commemorated in Auchtermuchty Cemetery
- \* Private James H Smith, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn., Black Watch.
- \* Private Henry [Harry] Suttie, 20<sup>th</sup> Bn., King's (Liverpool Regiment).

Private William Black, (a later addition to the roll of honour). Possibly Corporal William A Black, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn., Black Watch who is on the Falkland War Memorial. In the 1901 census he was living in Auchtermuchty.
